

First of all we would like to thank you for your prayer and contribution for our suffering people. The Lord has opened up doors and ways to reach out to these people in desperate need not only materially but also spiritually during the last 4 months. Our relationship with the Christian and non believers have been established through relief and rehabilitation of their livelihood in delta. Your partnership has really enhanced us to build deep relationship. We have experienced spiritual breakthrough in many churches and many non Christian villages. The wall of racism and denotionalism has been broken down in many of the churches. Without you we might have been so helpless and grieving just watching them suffering.

After 4 months of our relief work and after evaluation of our work there we are launching the Spiritual Movement and Church Planting Movement to take place in delta started from Laputta and Myaung Mya townships.

**Praise that our staff have great compassion for the affected, suffering people and actively involving in building their spiritual lives. They are so committed and pay all the cost their best to comfort these young and old in spite of limited resources.**

**Praise that people's heart are more opened to the gospel, the churches are more opened to have partnership with us to rebuild their lives and to reach out their neighbours in the midst of tragedy.**

**Praise for the provisions and protections from the Lord as the weather is severe especially in delta. Praise for the international donors who trust us and contributing the resources for reaching out to the least and the lost.**

**\*Pray for the training for the 28 pastors from Laputta, delta from 12-13 September.** Pray that they may know the Lord as their Saviour and Lord. Many pastors do not have personal relationship with the Lord yet. Pray that they may be strengthened by the Word and Prayer. Pray for our staff of CCC who is going to speak. Pray that the Lord may provide the resources in time.

**\*Pray for the days and nights of prayer for Myanmar sponsored by MCCR from 18-24 September.** Pray that we may be repentant and humbly seek the Lord, turned from our wicked ways and prayed to the Lord for the healing of our beloved country, Myanmar.

**\*Pray for the Spiritual Movement and Church Planting Ministry in delta.**

**\*Pray for the sufficient food distribution by UN, NGOs and local churches until harvest time.**

**\*Pray for the mission trips of the staff and the students from Stars of Dawn holistic development training centre to delta from December 15'08 to January 15'09.** Pray that the harvest of the souls may be harvested abundantly. Pray that the Lord may provide the entire plan, the strategy and the resources.

**\*Please pray for staff and workers from Coverage Ministry as they go on their 40 days of fasting and prayer from 1st October to 9th November.** Pray that they may be strengthened as they seek the Lord. The other CCC staff will join them partially.

**\*Pray for the CCCWomen** retreat which will be conducted in Chaing Mai from November 23-27. We would like to honour them who take no time of rest and comfort to reaching the cyclone victims. - iv. To assist necessary trainings for the farmers, fishermen and health workers.
- v. To assist financially for rehabilitation of livelihood.

### **PRAYER GUIDE:**

#### **1.9.2008 (Monday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for being able to live through to the 9<sup>th</sup> month of 2008 and for being able to worship and pray to the living God who is able to provide us with answers.
- ▶▶ Pray not be worried about the rising food prices, the destruction of wars, earthquakes, etc...that the Bible had prophesized would happen, but to be able to trust and believe in the Lord despite these problems.

#### **2.9.2008 (Tuesday)**

- ▶▶ Pray to the Lord to give knowledge to the scientists, who are inventing medicines for the yet-incurable illnesses, to be able to invent the cure in time.
- ▶▶ Pray for all youths not to start using harmful substances such as cigarettes, drugs, alcohol, etc... and to be able to avoid those dangers.

#### **3.9.2008 (Wednesday)**

- ▶▶ Praise His name for the children, whom we had been praying for, who are now able to go to school.
- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the government and donors who help from all aspects for these children to be able to go to school.

#### **4.9.2008 (Thursday)**

- ▶▶ Especially praise the Lord for the many children in cyclone affected areas, who are able to go to school.
- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the children in Sar Chet village, who received school kits from Myanmar Christian Coalition for Cyclone Relief and also for those who start going to school even though they haven't been interested in it before.

#### **5.9.2008 (Friday)**

- ▶▶ Young people who look up to foreign countries are being taught wrongfully by teachers from foreign countries who disparage the native teachers whom the Lord is using. Remember and pray for these false teachers and their followers.
- ▶▶ Pray for the believers who could not distinguish the Bible themselves, and are vacillating from one church or one group to another whenever they are deceived by wrong teachings.

#### **6.9.2008 (Saturday)**

- ▶▶ Please remember to pray for the young people not to follow one of these false people's strategy: the temptation of the opportunity to go abroad,.
- ▶▶ Please pray for the shepherds to be able to protect their flocks from these false persons' dangers by teaching them to perceive the Bible correctly.

#### **7.9.2008 (Sunday)**

- ▶▶ Pray that there will be many more missionaries and pastors who can prepare and share sermons with the power of the Holy Spirit and can move their congregation who came to listen to their sermons only once every week in less than an hour.
- ▶▶ Please pray that the church members will not only listen to the sermons but also become spiritually mature persons who can perceive the Bible wisely.

#### **8.9.2008 (Monday)**

- ▶▶ Pray to become believers who are the light and salt for our neighbors from Monday to Saturday and who could bring other friends to church in many following weeks.

**9.9.2008 (Tuesday)**

- ▶▶ Pray to become pastors and church members who carry out without fail the great responsibility that the Lord has committed to us.
- ▶▶ By becoming this, pray to be able to fulfill the Baptist Convention's goal in 2013, on the 200<sup>th</sup> Memorial of Judson.

**10.9.2008 (Wednesday)**

- ▶▶ Also pray for other churches and congregations that the Lord has built, in that they will become pastors, bishops and members who carry out without fail the great commission that the Lord has committed to them.
- ▶▶ Please pray that by doing so, every one of the Lord's churches will be able to spread the gospel to every corner of the earth and fulfill the Lord's command.

**11.9.2008 (Thursday)**

- ▶▶ Please pray that every missionary organizations that the Lord has built will follow the great responsibility that the Lord has commanded and will be organizations that carry it out without fail.
- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the churches, mission organizations, pastors, bishops, missionaries, etc...who respect, follow and carry out without fail the great commission that the Lord has commanded.

**13.9.2008 (Saturday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the doctors, nurses, and staff who are taking care of the lepers, whom most people neglect, with their knowledge, money, and compassion.
- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the special private hospitals and missionary hospitals for these people.

**14.9.2008 (Sunday)**

- ▶▶ Pray that the Lord will use the church pastors, missionaries, doctors and other persons to share gospel in the churches where they celebrate Leper's Day.
- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the donors and the doctors, nurses and staff who are working in Mawlamyaing, Mayanchaung, etc...in leper hospital and treatment centers.

**15.9.2008 (Monday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the organizations and private donors who help and empathize with the homeless, clothe-less people.
- ▶▶ Please pray that there will be more churches and believers who help the least of us as the Lord has commanded.

**16.9.2008 (Tuesday)**

- ▶▶ Please pray for those who are imprisoned without sufficient evidence; pray that the truth will prevail promptly and free them from their undeserved confinement.

**17.9.2008 (Wednesday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the believer congregation who, unlike the five foolish brides, wisely prepares and awaits the return of the Lord like the five wise brides.
- ▶▶ Please pray for those church members who, like the five foolish brides, ignore and make fun about the coming of Christ so that they will become wise and prepared.

**18.9.2008 (Thursday)**

- ▶▶ In the approach of the Day, people will give up meeting and so, praise the Lord for the believers who perseveres in attending meetings.
- ▶▶ Please pray for the church members who neglect meetings, as some are in the habit of doing, so that they may try to attend more meetings.

**19.9.2008 (Friday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord that there aren't any members who do not believe or mock the Day because the Bible prophesized that those who do so will be judged.
- ▶▶ If there were any of those who do not believe or mock the coming of the Lord, please pray that they will repent and become wiser.

**20.9.2008 (Saturday)**

- ▶▶ Tomorrow Sunday is "MIT Day" and please pray that the lecturers who share the sermons will be prepared by the Holy Spirit.
- ▶▶ Please pray to the Lord not only to provide anything that MIT's principal, lecturers, students might need, but also that they will be able to perceive the Bible wisely.

**21.9.2008 (Sunday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the seminaries that are producing His people and those who will nurture many good things.
- ▶▶ Please pray that there will be seminaries whose standards in education, faith, theology, etc...meet the Bible's standards.

**22.9.2008 (Monday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the attendance of those in the seminaries who are clever, of good character and love and give God the first place in their lives.
- ▶▶ Please pray that those who came to the seminaries for many other reasons will become wholesome and good people who do many good things such as sharing gospel, confessing, righting oneself, teaching the Bible, etc...

**23.9.2008 (Tuesday)**

- ▶▶ Please pray that there will be parents who send not only their disobedient sons and daughters to the seminaries, but also their most intelligent and obedient children so that they will serve the Lord.
- ▶▶ Please pray that their sons and daughters will understand that serving the Lord is not only rewarding, but also righteous; pray that they will give their best to the Lord.

**24.9.2008 (Wednesday)**

**27.9.2008 (Saturday)**

- ▶▶ Praise the Lord for the believers who, like the psalmist, invite the Lord to examine their hearts.

**28.9.2008 (Sunday)**
