Background of Transform Southeast Asia Summit 2008

Southeast Asia as located between the two great nations of India & China is a region in itself. It has historically been connected in one way or another through ancient trades & kingdoms, treaty (SEATO, 1954-1977) or now the togetherness in the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN, since 1967) to foster mutual cooperation & mutual assistance among member countries.

Spiritually, however, inter-denominational, inter-focus ministries connections, mutual cooperation between ministries in Southeast Asia for His Kingdom have still a long way to go. Yes, the Gospel has been planted in each of the 11 nations of SE Asia. However, about 80% of the 555 million of Southeast Asia population (SEA: 1/11 of World's Population) are still non-believers. From 10 people in Southeast Asia: about 4 are Muslims, 3 Buddhists, 1 Hindu & Animists and only about 2 Christians.

The societies & the nations atmosphere where the Gospel have been planted are not necessarily becoming friendlier either. The resurgence of non-Christian religions like Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism are influencing media & public opinion (e.g. against evangelism), cultures, even laws of the country (e.g. Shariah or its elements). These are making not only evangelism more difficult, but even posing serious challenges to Christianity itself & consequently its growth. Thus, not only transformation of individuals is so much needed, but as well social transformation of villages, cities & nations; not only for the growth but even in certain cases for the survival of churches.

The sad thing is, that in the midst of such great challenges, we (Christians), which are only 19,8% of Southeast Asia population, outside our own boxes, are practically "strangers" to one another's burdens & needs; How then, can we supplement & help one another for His Kingdom in Southeast Asia to prosper? With this basic concerns and challenges this summit are thus called.
