

## Transform Korea 2007 Declaration

300 servant catalysts of South Korea gathered together from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> of October 2007 for the 1<sup>st</sup> Transform Korea Consultation at the Hallelujah Community Church in response to God's call for "New Korea for a New World." As a result of our consultation, we make firm declaration as follows:

1. We declare that we will pursue biblical transformation in all areas of life and institutions, starting from personal sphere to the spheres of family, church, society and the state.

2. We declare that we will carry on our practical resolutions in the following three areas --

First, we will study the status of each focus sphere, cast transformational visions according to God's will, set medium and long range goals, design strategies to reach the goals, prepare action points and present these to the fellow Korean believers for them to play servant catalysts for transformation in their spheres.

Second, we will facilitate, encourage and support for on-going transformational movement to emerge, in the spirit of voluntary connectivity, nationally and among regions, churches and individuals.

Third, we will strengthen global servant leadership through staying linked to global Transform World Connections.

3. We declare the year 2007 as the first year of Transform Korea Movement. We will put in our prayerful efforts to create New Korea for a New World, a nation after God's heart, and continually network internationally to facilitate this global movement through participating in and contributing to various transformational meetings and initiatives in the spirit of global alliance.

4. We declare that Christ is the agent of transformation, whom we commit ourselves to follow. We will facilitate for the whole church of both national and global Koreans to be deeply involved in this transformational movement.
