Transform Korea Connection's steering committee meeting was held on the 10th of January 2008 to steer direction of on-going transformational movement in Korea and beyond. Rev. Dr. Sang Bok David Kim, chairman of Transform Korea Connection, emphasized that transformation is God's calling for all believers to respond. Various issues were discussed thereafter.

A nation-building & governance focus group was emerged at the meeting and would be added to the Transform Korea Connection. It was proposed for the group to be facilitated by Dr. Young Joon Kwon, professor of Kyunghee University and some other leaders in political area. Dr. Kwon was a presenter of "Communal Capitalism," with Dr. Sang Dal Shim of Korea Development Institute, at the Transform World Summit 2007 held in Korea last October.

The steering committee would move toward the Transform World Summit 2007, which will take place in the 2nd week of May 2009 at Hallelujah Community Church, Korea. An event secretariat is expected to be launched soon to take care of on-going administrative and connecting activities. The Transform Korea Connection would encourage denominations and missions to take part in the event.

The Transform Korea Connection will utilize Prayer Herald and READ magazines as official media to spread sphere-wise prayer points for the nation and transformational values and information.

Transform Korea Connection's Women focus group organized an event in December 17-19, 2007 at Hallelujah Community Church to focus on women's spirituality and transformation. The women focus group would encourage members to participate in different functional focus groups of Transform Korea Connection.

The Business focus group of Transform Korea Connection jointly organized with other groups Transform Workplace Conference 2008 at the Olympic Hall of the Olympic Park on January 28 through 31, 2008 to facilitate kingdom business and transform workplaces. The rally held under the title of "Your business is your mission." was participated by a maximum of 3,000 leaders in business circles and spiritual leaders.

SaRang Community Church will soon launch a Transform City Initiative. It is expected to closely partner with Transform Chuncheon, Transform Pohang, Transform Houston 2008 and Transform NY 2009 and other transform city initiatives.
