A brief report of South East Asia Prayer Council 2010 12-15 October 2010

This was the word released before and during the South-East Asia Prayer Consultation 2010, held from 12-15 October, in Cisarua-Puncak, West Java, Indonesia. In the last few years, we have already seen great shaking in our region of South-East Asia: earthquakes, tsunami, typhoons, severe flooding, political unrest, etc. This is going to continue and possibly increase in the near future. Are we, the Body of Christ, ready? We have to prepare ourselves now, not wait until the disaster takes place.

40 delegates from outside Indonesia joined more than 800 local intercessors and prayer mobilisers in a week of intense prayer for nations. It was a time of humbling ourselves before God and one another. Reconciliation took place between Hong Kong and the Philippines over the hostage crisis in August. Indonesia and Malaysia asked forgiveness from one another over the treatment of Indonesian workers in Malaysia. We prayed for the upcoming elections in Myanmar, that there would be peace and no bloodshed. We lifted up prayer for Brunei, Cambodia and Vietnam, as our brothers and sisters shared their burdens for their nations.



We were also blessed by speakers from Malaysia, the Philippines, USA and Germany. The word of God came through loud and clear: prayer and action! If we want to see transformation in our communities, cities and nations, we must not only pray, but we must act on our prayers.
